PRODUCTION AND VALUE OF MAPLE PRODUCTS 1952

The production of maple products (expressed as syrup) was considerably higher in 1952 than in either of the two immediately preceding years, and was also well above the 1945-49 average. The volume of production this year was 50 per cent greater than last year while the total returns to farmers were up 42 per cent.

The output of maple syrup was larger in 1952 than in 1951 in all provinces in which maple products are produced. The maple sugar make on farms however, was greater only in New Brunswick and Quebec. The Province of Quebec remained by far the most important producer accounting for 85 per cent of the syrup and 93 per cent of the sugar in 1952.

The price to the producers of syrup was lower in 1952 than in 1951 for all provinces except New Brunswick where a small increase was reported. Sugar prices, on the other hand, were higher in all provinces. The fact that higher prices for sugar were associated with greater production suggests that the weather conditions which brought about an increased flow of sap also favoured a high quality product this year,
