PRODUCTION OF MAPLE PRODUCTS 1963 and VALUE OF MAPLE PRODUCTS 1962

The 1963 production of maple products (expressed as syrup) at 2.8 million gallons was 1 per cent below the 1962 crop and 9 per cent above the 1956-60 average. Maple syrup outturn, estimated at 2.7 million gallons, was above the 1956-60 average of 2.5 million gallons. Total farm-made sugar production declined to 720 thousand pounds from 750 thousand in 1962. Maple sugar outturn in 1963 was then equivalent to about 0.1 million gallons of syrup.

In 1963, the syrup crop in Quebec reached 2.5 million gallons slightly over the previous year's 2.4 million gallons. Sugar production in 1963 was then equivalent to 0.1 million gallons of syrup. In Ontario, production of both sugar and syrup was less in 1963 than in 1962, while in Nova Scotia both crops were up. New Brunswick reported a larger syrup output in 1963 than in 1962 with exactly the same volume of sugar production in both years.

Estimates of the prices received by farmers for maple products in 1963 are not yet available. Estimated farm prices and returns to farmers from the sale of maple products in 1962, with comparable figures for earlier years are shown in Tables 3, 4 and 5.

The total value of production of maple products for the 1962 crop in Canada stood at 11.0 million dollars, about 6 per cent above the revised 1961 figure of 10.4 million Maple syrup made up 10.6 million dollars of the total while farm-made sugar accounted for 374 thousand dollars. The average farm price for syrup of \$3.85 per gallon was moderately below the 1961 average of \$3.91. Sugar prices averaged 50 cents per pound, slightly above the previous year's 49 cents, with reductions in all producing provinces except Quebec.

This report includes revised figures for maple sugar production for the Province of Quebec for the years 1955-61 inclusive. These revisions were based on the results of the 1961 Census.
