PRODUCTION OF MAPLE PRODUCTS 1965 AND VALUE OF MAPLE PRODUCTS 1964

The 1965 production of maple products (expressed as syrup) reached 2.2 million gallons, 25 per cent above the 1964 crop of 1.8 million. Maple syrup which makes up the bulk of the production was well above last years figure of 1.7 million. Total farm made sugar production was also up to 494 thousand pounds this year compared with 478 thousand last year. Although the total maple crop was considerably above that of last year it was still below production in 1963 and the 1958-62 crop of 2.5 million gallons.

The bulk of the maple crop was produced in Quebec where syrup production totalled 1,957,000 gallons this year, 25 per cent above the 1.6 million of 1964. However farm-made sugar production was about 5 per cent lower this year than last year in Quebec but higher in N.S., N.B. and Ontario.

The 1965 season was very backward in starting and the outlook seemed disappointing until near the end of the flow, when conditions changed for the better and some very heavy runs were experienced.

Estimates of the farm value of the 1965 crop are not yet available. Estimated returns to farmers from the sale of maple products in 1964 with comparable figures for earlier years are shown in tables 3, 4 and 5.

The total value of production of maple products for the 1964 crop in Canada stood at 7.6 million dollars, sharply below the 11.4 million of the previous season due to the restricted output in 1964. Maple syrup made up 7.3 million dollars of the total while farm made sugar amounted to \$271,000.

Reference to maple sugar in this report is to farm made sugar only and does not include any maple sugar produced elsewhere.
