PRODUCTION OF MAPLE PRODUCTS 1969 AND VALUE OF MAPLE PRODUCTS 1968

The 1969 production of maple products (expressed as syrup) stood at 1.97 million gallons, 27 per cent below the 1968 crop of 2.71 million. Maple Syrup which makes up the bulk of the production was below last years out-turn. Total farm made sugar production declined to 364,000 pounds from 423,000 pounds in 1968. Quebec producers made 468,000 pounds of taffy this year compared with 478,000 pounds in 1968.

The bulk of the maple crop was produced in Quebec where syrup production totalled 1,678,000 gals. this year, 29 per cent below the 2,371,000 gallons of 1968. Production of syrup was lower in all provinces except New Brunswick this year while the production of farm-made sugar was lower in all provinces except Nova Scotia.

Estimates of the farm value of the 1969 crop are not yet available. However estimated returns to farmers from the sale of maple products in 1968 with comparative figures for earlier years are shown in tables 3, 4 and 5.

The total value of production of maple products for the 1968 crop in Canada stood at 12.0 million dollars which is up slightly from the 11.2 million dollars of the previous season. Maple syrup and a 11.4 million dollars of the total while farm made sugar amounted to 282,000 dollars.

Reference to maple sugar in this report is to farm-made sugar only and does not include any maple sugar produced elsewhere.
