TOBACCO CROP REPORT

Infomation supplied by the Tobacco Division, Central Experimental Farm, indicates that total Company aquisitions of tobacco from the 1949 crop, on a green weight basis, mounted to 139,820,000 lb. This was made up of 116,668,000 lb. of flue-cured, 15,452,000 lb. of burley, 3,706,000 lb. of cigar, 2,104,000 lb. of dark and 1,890,000 lb. of pipe tobacco. The total value of the crop was \$55,453,000. Average prices paid to growers, by types, were as follows: flue-cured, 42.08 cents per lb.; burley, 30.47 cents per lb.; cigar, 22.5 cents per lb.; dark, 23.29 cents per lb. and pipe tobacco, 17.04 cents per lb.
