TOBACCO PRODUCTION AND VALUE 1952

May 20, 1953. - The estimated production of tobacco in Canada was 139,719,000 pounds in 1952 almost 10 per cent loss than in 1951. The fluo-cured (cigarette tobacco) crop in Ontario exceeded 127 million pounds in 1952 down from the previous year by about 13 million pounds. This accounted for practically all of the decrease in the 1952 Canadian tobacco crop. Although the planted acreage of flue-cured types had been severly reduced in preparation for the 1952 crop, the abnormal yield per acre of this type produced a much more abundant crop than anticipated, providing the unprecedented record of 1,567 pounds in Ontario. Yields of other types were somewhat larger than 1951 with the one exception Dark Tobacco. The average price to the grower for all types of leaf was 40.79 cents, lower than the average of 43.05 cents for the 1951 crop.
