LEAF TOBACCO PRODUCTION AND VALUE 1956

The estimated production of leaf tobacco (green weight) in Canada in the crop year ending September 30, 1956 amounted to 170,278,000 pounds approximately 35 million pounds more than that which was harvested in 1955. Canadian growers received \$76,012,000 for this 1955 production, \$19,000,000 more than the previous year. The producers within the Province of Ontario grossed \$72,604,000 compared to \$53,531,000 in 1955.

In 1956 the Flue-cured Tobacco Marketing Board agreed to return to 91 per cent of the full base acreage following the reduced harvested crop in 1955. This factor plus more than average growing and harvesting conditions in the Ontario Flue-cured crop produced a higher proportion of marketable tobacco than anticipated. Loss of tobacco from weather and disease was not great in 1956. The yields from acreage of Ontario Flue-cured tobacco increased from 1,249 pounds in 1955 to 1,370 pounds per acre in 1956.

The acreages of Burley tobacco increased from 4,033 acres in 1955 to 4,496 acres in 1956. However, yields per acre decreased from 1,737 pounds to 1,563 pounds per acre respectively.

The overall yield per acre of green-weight leaf tobacco increased to 1,333 pounds in 1956 compared to the 1955 yield of 1,227 pounds per acre. By types, the yield per acre for 1956 together with the respective 1955 yield in brackets, are as follows: Flue-cured, 1,339 (1,202); Burley, 1,563 (1,737); Dark, 1,520 (1,747); Cigar, 1,050 (1,279); and Pipe, 873 (1,016).
