LEAF TOBACCO ACREAGE, PRODUCTION AND VALUE, 1960

(Crop Year Ending September 30, 1960)

An estimated production of leaf tobacco (green weight) in Canada in the crop year ending September 30, 1960 amounted to 214,167,000 pounds, an increase of approximately 45,000,000 pounds more than was harvested in 1959 and, historically, the largest crop on record. On this basis, the total farm value is estimated at \$114,699,000 (4). Prices paid for this crop increased to 53.56 cents per pound compared to 53.21 cents per pound for the 1959 crop. The total crop was harvested from 135,962 acres while the average yield per acre increased to 1575 pounds compared to 1326 pounds per acre in 1959.

A crop of 199,521,000 pounds of Flue-cured tobacco was grown in Ontario in the year under review. This compares to the 146,675,000 pounds harvested in the previous year. Average prices decreased to 54.65 cents per pound in 1960 compared to 55.57 cents per pound one year earlier. The total farm value based on total crop produced, is estimated at \$109,036,000. This crop was harvested from 123,831 acres which returned a yield of 1611 pounds per acre. It should be recorded that a few acres of Flue-cured tobacco were grown in Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and Manitoba this year from which approximately 49,000 pounds were realized.

There was no Burley tobacco commercially produced in either Ontario or Quebec this year with the exception of approximately 10 acres of this type grown in Ontario.

The over-all yield per acre of green weight leaf tobacco increased from 1326 in 1959 to 1575 pounds in 1960. By types, the yield per acre for 1960, together with the respective 1959 yields in brackets are as follows: Flue-cured 1592 (1305); Burley 1200 (1748); Dark 1392 (1598); Cigar 1303 (1306); Pipe 1036 (1084).
