LEAF TOBACCO ACREAGE, PRODUCTION AND VALUE, 1963

(Crop Year Ending September 30, 1963)

An estimated production of leaf tobacco (green weight) in Canada in the crop year ending September 30, 1963 amounted to 201,144,000 pounds, a decrease of approximately 2,000,000 pounds than was harvested in 1962. On this basis, the total farm value is estimated at \$90,633,000(3). Prices paid for this crop decreased to 45.08 cents per pound. From 113,893 acres, the average yield per acre increased to 1,766 pounds compared to 1,550 pounds per acre in 1962.

A crop of 180,297,000 pounds of flue-cured tobacco was grown in Ontario in the current crop year. This volume is comparable to 180,648,000 pounds harvested in the previous year. The average price paid to tobacco producers was 45.65 cents per pound in 1963 compared to 48.33 cents per pound one year earlier. The total farm value, based on the total crop produced, is estimated at \$82,596,000. In 1963 there were 99,537 acres of tobacco harvested in the province, approximately 17,000 less than 116,671 acres harvested in 1962. It should be noted that there was no tobacco of this type produced in British Columbia or Manitoba in the current year but small acreages were again harvested in 1963 in Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick.

The Burley tobacco commercial harvest in 1963 amounted to 8,808,000 pounds and was produced from 4,241 acres. Improved varieties planted in the current crop year produced an average yield of 2,086 pounds per acre.

The over-all yield per acre of green-weight leaf tobacco increased from 1,548 in 1962 to 1,766 pounds in 1963. By types, the yield per acre for 1963, together with the respective 1962 yields in brackets are as follows: flue-cured, 1,764 (1,533); burley, 2,077 (1,952); dark, 1,588 (1,398); cigar, 1,625 (1,716); pipe, 901 (1,038).
