## LEAF TOBACCO ACREAGE, PRODUCTION AND VALUE, 1966

(Crop Year Ending September 30, 1966)

An estimated production of leaf tobacco (green-weight) in Canada in the crop year ending September 30, 1966 amounted to 233,976,000 pounds, an increase of 65,096,000 pounds over the 168,880,000 pounds harvested in 1965. Of this increase, 64.6 million pounds occurred in the production of flue-cured tobacco. Production of burley tobacco increased 1.5 million pounds while production of dark (air-cured and fire-cured) and cigar tobacco were down slightly.

The value of this increased tobacco crop is estimated at \$163,947,000. This increased crop was harvested from an estimated 131,419 acres which gave an average yield of 1,780 pounds per acre which brought an estimated average price of 70.70 cents per pound.

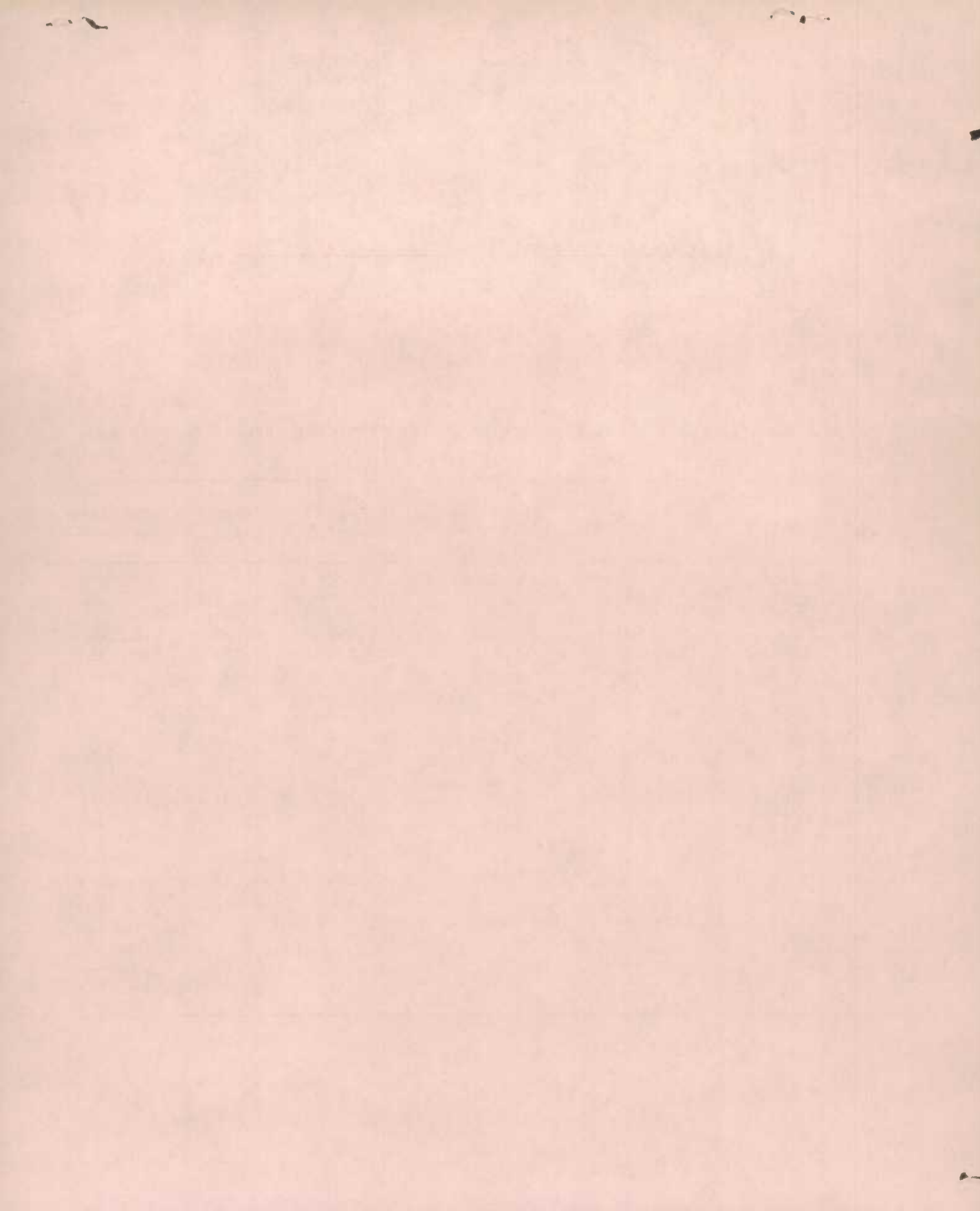
