

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF THE WHEAT SITUATION

November 18, 1937



International Trade:

World shipments for the week ending November 13, 1937 amounted to 11,771,000 bushels compared with 11,840,000 bushels in the previous week and 12,984,000 bushels in the corresponding week last year.

Cumulative world shipments from August 1 to November 13, 1937 were 136,811 bushels compared with 167,176,000 bushels for the same period in 1936.

Primary Movement:

Receipts at country elevators and platform loadings for the week ending November 12, 1937 were 2,694,077 bushels, compared with 4,331,575 bushels in the previous week, and 2,013,540 bushels in the corresponding week a year ago.

Cumulative receipts at country elevators and platform loadings from August 1 to November 12, 1937 were 88,507,521 bushels, compared with 125,530,819 bushels for the same period in 1936.

Visible Supply:

The visible supply of Canadian wheat on November 12, 1937 was 72,867,969 bushels, compared with 74,244,392 bushels in the previous week, and 142,489,972 bushels a year ago.

Export Clearances:

Overseas export clearances of Canadian wheat for the week ending November 12, 1937 were 3,084,965 bushels, compared with 1,848,320 bushels for the previous week and 4,833,799 bushels for the corresponding week a year ago.

Imports of Canadian wheat into the United States for consumption and milling in bond for the week ending November 12, 1937 were 63,000 bushels compared with 39,000 bushels for the previous week and 740,000 bushels for the corresponding week in 1936.

Cumulative overseas clearances plus United States imports of wheat from August 1 to November 12, 1937 were 30,549,382 bushels, compared with 78,288,896 bushels for the same period in 1936.

Prices:

The Winnipeg cash closing price of No. 1 Northern on Tuesday, November 16, 1937 was \$1.35 $\frac{1}{4}$  showing a decrease of  $\frac{1}{2}$  a cent from the previous Tuesday's close of \$1.35 $\frac{3}{4}$ .
