## International Trade

World shipments for the week ending November 19, 1938 amounted to $11,967,000$ bushels compared with $11,463,000$ bushels in the previous week and /k $11,336,000$ bushels in the corresponding week last year.

Cumulative world shipments from August 1 to November 19, 1938 were $181,270,000$ bushels compared with $148,336,000$ bushels for the same period in 1937.

Primary Movement
Receipts at country elevators for the week ending November 18, 1938 were $4,952,195$ bushels as compared with $4,918,374$ bushels for the previous week and 1,981,693 bushels for the corresponding week a year ago.

Cumulative receipts at country elevators from August 1 to November 18, 1938 were $238,860,714$ bushels, compared with $90,489,214$ bushels in the same period in 1938.

## Visible Supply

The visible supply of Canadian wheat on November 18,1938 was $176,879,112$ bushels, compared with $179,744,490$ bushels in the previous week and $69,824,374$ bushels a year ago.

## Export Clearances

Overseas export clearances of Canadian wheat for the week ending November 18, 1938 were $4,965,424$ bushels, compared with $4,047,091$ bushels for the previous week and $2,494,099$ bushels for the corresponding week a year ago.

Imports of Canadian wheat into the United States for consumption and milling in bond for the week ending November 18,1938 were 154,000 bushels as compared with 197,000 bushels for the previous week and 30,000 bushels for the corresponding week in 1937.

Cumulative overseas clearances plus United States imports of wheat from August 1, 1938 to November 18, 1938 were $57,206,704$ bushels, compared with 32,727,232 bushels for the same period in 1937.

## Prices

The Winnipeg cash closing price of No. 1 Northern on Tuesday November 22, 1938 was $591 / 8$ cents showing a decrease of $17 / 8$ cents from the previous Tuesday's close of 61 cents.
