WEEKLY SUMMARY OF THE WHEAT SITUATION

SEPTEMBER 21, 1939

International Trade

World shipments for the week ending September 16, 1939 amounted to 6,209,000 bushels compared with 10,267,000 bushels in the previous week and 8,960,000 bushels in the corresponding week last year.

Cumulative world shipments from August 1, 1939 to September 16, 1939 were 65,119,000 bushels compared with 77,816,000 bushels for the same period in 1938.

Primary Movement

Primary receipts of wheat for the week ending September 15, 1939 were 38,418,578 bushels as compared with the revised figure of 42,538,346 bushels for the previous week and 20,725,068 bushels for the corresponding week a year ago.

Revised cumulative receipts from August 1, 1939 to September 15, 1939 were 140,677,131 bushels compared with 99,502,773 bushels in the same period in 1938.

Visible Supply

The visible supply of Canadian wheat on September 15, 1939 was 221,952,832 bushels compared with 180,731,302 bushels in the previous week and 103,006,259 bushels a year ago.
