

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF THE WHEAT SITUATION

SEPTEMBER 28, 1939

International Trade

World shipments for the week ending September 23, 1939 amounted to 7,613,000 bushels compared with 6,209,000 bushels in the previous week and 9,200,000 bushels in the corresponding week last year.

Cumulative world shipments from August 1, 1939 to September 23, 1939 were 72,414,000 bushels compared with 87,016,000 bushels for the same period in 1938.

Primary Movement

Primary receipts of wheat for the week ending September 23, 1939 were 35,076,215 bushels as compared with the revised figure of 42,821,114 bushels for the previous week and 32,148,351 bushels for the corresponding week a year ago.

Revised cumulative receipts from August 1, 1939 to September 22, 1939 were 180,155,882 bushels compared with 131,651,124 bushels in the same period in 1938.

Visible Supply

The visible supply of Canadian wheat on September 22, 1939 was 254,943,864 bushels compared with 221,952,832 bushels in the previous week and 131,586,568 bushels a year ago.
