

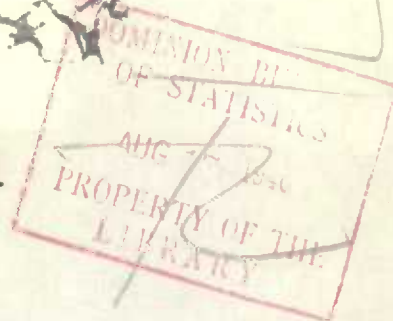

WEEKLY SUMMARY OF THE WHEAT SITUATION

AUGUST 14, 1940



International Trade

World shipments for the week ending August 10, 1940 amounted to 4,789,000 bushels compared with 7,286,000 bushels in the previous week and 10,508,000 bushels in the corresponding week last year.

Cumulative world shipments from August 1 to August 10, 1940 were 12,075,000 bushels compared with 19,656,000 bushels for the same period in 1939.

Primary Movement

Primary receipts of wheat for the week ending August 9, 1940 were 2,218,893 bushels compared with the revised figure of 4,982,434 bushels for the previous week and 3,710,024 bushels for the corresponding period a year ago.

Visible Supply

The visible supply of Canadian wheat on August 9, 1940 was 281,950,758 bushels as compared with 282,280,550 bushels in the previous week and 92,543,432 bushels a year ago.

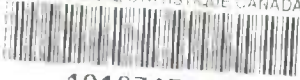
Export Clearances

Overseas export clearances of Canadian wheat for the week ending August 9, 1940 were 1,532,610 bushels, compared with 848,137 bushels for the previous week and 4,131,801 bushels for the corresponding week a year ago.

Prices

The Winnipeg cash closing price of No. 1 Northern on Tuesday, August 13, 1940 was 72 cents, showing an increase of 1/8 of a cent over the previous Tuesday's close of 71 7/8 cents.
