Ottawa, February 21, 1947- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the Dominion and Provincial Departments of Agriculture issues to-day a preliminary report on the production and value of Hops in Canada in 1946.

SUMMARY

Preliminary estimates of acreage of hops in Canada indicate that the area in 1946 increased slightly and amounted to 2,048 acres compared with the acreage in 1945 of 1,962 acres. While a smaller area was devoted to this crop in Quebec during the present season, the area in Ontario and British Columbia was somewhat larger than in the previous season. Yields were up considerably in all provinces and the average for Canada is estimated at 977 pounds per acre compared with 881 pounds per acre for the previous crop. Canadian production this year exceeds that of the 1945 crop by 272,000 pounds being estimated at 2,000,000 pounds. Prices declined sharply, however, with the average currently estimated at 75 cents per pound. This gives the crop a total value of \$1,500,000.
