OFFAIA - September 22, 1948 - The Dominion Eureau of Statistics in co-operation with the Federal and Provincial Department's of Agriculture issues to-day a report on the acreage, production and value of hops in Canada in 1948.

## HOPS

The first estimate of production of hops this year indicates that the crop is 31% smaller than that of a year ago. The crop is currently estimated at 1,721,000 lb. compared with 2,491,000 lb. harvested in 1947. Reduced acreages are reported in Ontario and British Columbia while in Quebec the area remained unchanged. In Ontario and Quebec the average vield is somewhat better but in British Columbia the yield per acree is smaller than that of last season.

Production in 1948, by provinces, with comparable data for 1947 in brackets is: Quebec, 33,000 lb. (30,000 lb.); Ontario 88,000 lb. (141,000 lb.); British Columbia, 1,600,000 lb. (2,330,000 lb.).

The preliminary estimates of the total value of the crop also show a decline from last season. The average price remains practically unchanged at 80 cents per 1b. with the result that the reduced crop is valued at \$1,372,000 or \$584,000 less than the value of the 1947 harvest.
