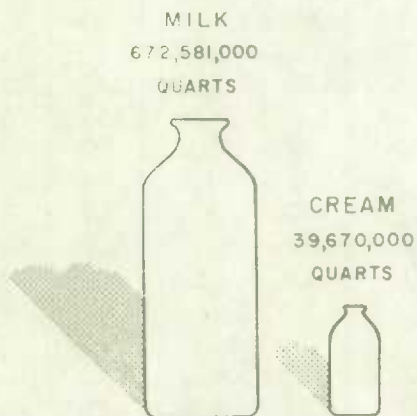

## FARM CASH INCOME FROM DAIRYING AND FLUID SALES

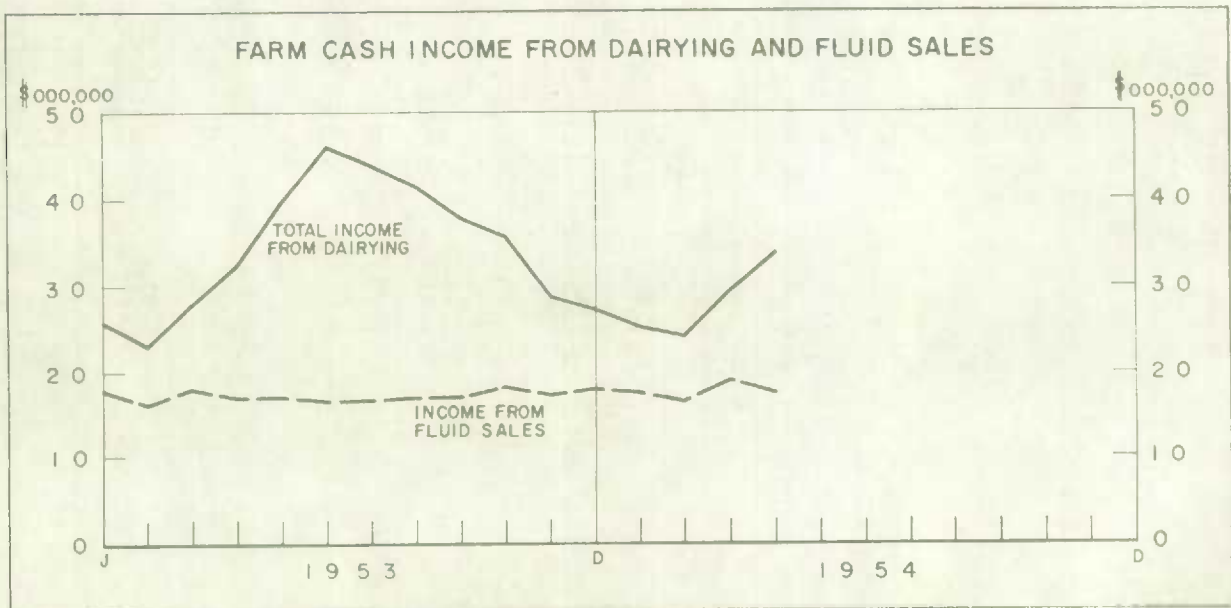
