REPORT ON LIVESTOCK SURVEYS

CATTLE - SHEEP - HORSES, DECEMBER 1, 1961

CATTLE: The number of cattle and calves on farms in Canada at December 1, 1961 is estimated at 11,111,000, about 2 per cent greater than the year-earlier total of 10,897,000 head. The number of milk cows increased 70,000 to 3,200,000 head with most of the gain occurring in Quebec and Ontario. Holdings of beef cows increased in all provinces but Quebec for a net gain of 95,400, or over 4 per cent. Farm inventories of heifers, steers and calves were also greater than last year in Eastern Canada and these increases partially offset reduced holdings of these classes in the West. While the rate of increase is less than during the two previous years these estimates indicate that breeding stock has continued to increase, even in the West despite the adverse feed production season in 1961.

SHEEP: Estimated at 1,071,000 head, the number of sheep and lambs was about 5.5 per cent below the total at December 1, 1960. Except for Ontario, in which there was an increase, numbers of sheep and lambs were lower than a year ago in all provinces.

HORSES: The number of horses at December 1, 1961 is estimated at 516,000 head, down over 6 per cent from the year-earlier total. The decrease of 5 per cent in the East and almost 8 per cent in the West was a continuation of the consistent, long-term trend.
