REPORT ON LIVESTOCK SURVEYS H O G S, December 1, 1965

The number of hogs on farms in Canada(1) at December 1, 1965 is estimated at 5,106,000 down 8 per cent from 5,575,000 at December 1, 1964. Numbers are down 16 per cent in the West and 2 per cent in the East. All provinces except Prince Edward Island (up 11 per cent) and British Columbia (no change) showed decreases.

The fall pig crop (pigs saved from litters born during the six-month period ending November 30) of 4,055,000 was 5 per cent below the 1964 fall crop of 4,269,000. In the West the fall pig crop was about 12 per cent less than last year's although Manitoba and British Columbia had 6 per cent increases. The East as a whole had a crop which was practically unchanged from last year with Prince Edward Island and Quebec having increases and the others decreases.

The June 1, 1965 forecast of sows to farrow was 522,300 and the December 1 survey now indicates the total farrowed was 511,000. The forecast for the West was high by 10,000, and that for the East was low by only 1,200.

Intentions reported at December 1, 1965 indicate that spring farrowings will be about 566,500 which, if realized, would mean a 10 per cent increase over last year's spring farrowings. The West could have a 9 per cent increase and the East an 11 per cent increase. All provinces have reported increases.
