REPORT OF LIVESTOCK SURVEYS HOGS, SEPTEMBER 1, 1967.

Hog numbers on farms in Canada(1) at September 1, 1967 were estimated at 6,251, 000, 6 percent more than the September 1, 1966 estimate of 5,923,000. In the East the number was estimated at 3,656,000, up 4 percent from a year earlier and in the West at 2,595,000, an increase of 8 percent. Nova Scotia numbers remained unchanged whereas all other Provinces registered increases.

Farrowings in June-August 1967 were estimated at 305,900, an increase of 4 percent over the same period of 1966. Farrowings, during this period, increased by 6 percent in the East and 2 percent in the West over the same period a year earlier. The forecast of farrowings for the September-November period is 303,700, an increase of 9 percent above the fourth quarter farrowings of 1966. The forecast of farrowings for the June to November period has been reduced slightly from a 9 percent increase to a 7 percent increase over reported farrowings during the same period in 1966.

The number of sows and gilts kept for breeding at September 1, 1967 was estimated at 672,500, a 6 percent increase from September 1, 1966.
