REPORT ON THE POULTRY SURVEY OF JUNE 1, 1962

Estimates of the number of poultry on farms in Canada $\underline{1}$ / at June 1, 1962 are based on farmer's replies to the semi-annual farm survey and the Census count in 1961 together with hatchery data available through the Canada Department of Agriculture. The series of estimates previously published for June and December from 1956 to 1960 are not directly comparable to these data for 1961 and 1962. Revision of the estimates for the intercensal period will be published at a later date.

The total of all poultry on farms at June 1, 1962 estimated at 72.2 million birds, was 7 per cent lower than at June 1, 1961 when the comparable Census total was 77.8 million birds. The estimate for June 1, 1962 includes 64,915,000 hens and chickens; 6,648,000 turkeys; 283,000 geese and 383,000 ducks.

The estimate of 64.9 million hens and chickens is 6 per cent lower than the 69.4 million on farms at June 1, 1961. Although there were 3 per cent more hens than a year earlier this increase was more than offset by declines of 7 per cent for pullets, 11 per cent for chicks, and 20 per cent for other classes, principally broilers.

In these comparisons with 1961 the Census data have been used for the total of all chickens, and for laying hens and pullets six months old and older. Census data for chicks under 2 months old have been adjusted upward to show closer relationship to hatchery statistics. A compensating downward adjustment of Census data was made for pullets under six months old, and for other birds 2 months old and older, not intended for laying.

As the result of a decrease in turkey poult hatch there were 13 per cent fewer turkeys on farms at June 1, 1962 than a year earlier. Decreases in the number of turkeys occurred in every province except Ontario where a modest 2 per cent increase occurred. The number of geese and ducks were 10 and 24 per cent lower than last year respectively.

1/ Current estimates for Newfoundland are not available. The Census of June 1, 1961 reports 231,385 head of poultry on farms. By class, the numbers reported were: hens and chickens, 227,929; turkeys, 2,468; geese, 467; ducks, 521. Elsewhere than on farms there were 61,003 hens and chickens and 1,305 other poultry.
