REPORT ON THE POULTRY SURVEY OF JUNE 1, 1963

The total number of all poultry on farms in Canada <u>1</u>/ at June 1, 1963 estimated at 73.8 million birds was 2 per cent higher than at June 1, 1962 when the comparable total was 72.2 million birds. The estimate of June 1, 1963 includes 66,530,000 hens and chickens; 6,573,000 turkeys; 309,100 geese and 376,100 ducks.

The estimate of 66.5 million hens and chickens is 2 per cent higher than the June 1962 estimate of 64.9 million. There were fewer 'hens' as well as fewer 'pullets' for layer replacement than a year earlier but these decreases were more than offset by increases in the number of 'chicks' and 'others' (chickens 2 months and older not intended for laying).

The estimated number of turkeys on farms at June 1 was about 1 per cent lower than last year. Increases are indicated in Nova Scotia and Ontario while Prince Edward Island and Manitoba remain unchanged. All other provinces had less. There were 2 per cent fewer ducks on farms than a year ago but the number of geese increased by 9 per cent.

Estimates of poultry numbers on farms are based on semiannual mailed questionnaire surveys conducted in co-operation with Provincial Government Departments at June 1 and December 1 and on hatchery statistics compiled by the Canada Department of Agriculture. The semi-annual estimates of poultry numbers provide a basis for monthly estimates of number of layers and egg production. Revised monthly estimates of egg production for the period Jan.-June will appear in the July report 'Production of Eggs', Cat. No. 23-003. The 1962 report 'Production of Poultry and Eggs', Cat. No. 23-202 is now available. It covers the period 1941 to 1962 with estimates for 1956-61 being revised to conform with census data.

1/ Current estimates for Newfoundland are not available. The census of June 1, 1961 reports 231,385 head of poultry on farms. By class, the numbers reported were: hens and chickens, 227,929; turkeys, 2,466; geese, 467; ducks, 521. Elsewhere than on farms there were 61,003 hens and chickens and 1,305 other poultry.
