## FIRST ESTIMATE OF HONEY PRODUCTION, 1963 \*

Preliminary estimates indicate that a honey crop of 42.3 million pounds was produced in 1963, 38 per cent above the 1962 crop of 30.7 million pounds and substantially higher than the 35.0 million pounds produced in 1961. Production this year is also above the 1951-60 average by about 45 per cent and it is the largest crop since 1948, when production reached 45.2 million pounds. The increase in output this year compared with 1962, was brought about by a 6 per cent increase in colony numbers which reached a total of 359,410 and a 31 per cent increase in the average yields to 118 pound per colony. The number of active beekeepers, estimated at 10.180 this year, was slightly below the 10.370 of 1962.

Honey production was higher in 1963 than in 1962 in all provinces except Ontario. The higher yields are attributed to generally favourable weather conditions throughout most of Canada. In Ontario, where the reduction from 1962 is quite limited, dry weather in July is blamed for the smaller average yield. The largest increase in production from 1962 occurred in the province of Alberta, where an estimated 11.4 million pounds of honey were produced this year, placing Alberta in the position of being the largest producer of this commodity. A very much larger proportion of the 1963 crop was produced in the four western provinces this year than last.

Average yields per colony in 1963 were above those recorded in the period 1951-60 in all provinces, except British Columbia. In all provinces numbers of beekeepers were substantially lower this year than during the previous de cade.

\* Source: Estimates for the province of Quebec are prepared by the Bureau of Statistics, Department of Trade and Commerce, of that province. all other provinces, except Newfoundland, for which data are not available, the estimates are prepared by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the Provinces. Three mail questionnaire surveys are conducted, one in July to obtain the number of colonies and another in September to determine yields. This report is based on the results of the July and September surveys. A final yield and price survey is conducted later. Provincial officials provide the mailing lists of beekeepers and aid in the interpretation of survey results.
