ESTIMATED VALUE OF HONEY PRODUCTION, 1963

The revised estimate of the 1963 honey crop stands at 42.1 million pounds, an increase of 37 per cent over the 1962 outturn of 30.7 million pounds and 20 per cent above that of 1961. The larger quantities of honey produced in 1963 were due to a higher average yield per colony, and to a lesser extent to an increase in the number of colonies of bees. The number of colonies was also higher in 1963 than in 1961 and larger than the average for the period 1951-1960.

The total value of honey produced in Canada in 1963 is estimated at 7.8 million dollars, an increase of 52 per cent over the value of the 1962 crop. These figures represent estimated total returns to be keepers for honey, not including the cost of containers. Beekeepers replying to the second honey survey of the 1963 crop, which was completed in the early part of 1964, were asked to indicate the average price received for their honey. In the case of those petronizing co-operatives, final payments to the individual producers were not known at the time this survey was made. Therefore, co-operative establishments handling honey in Canada were asked to prepare estimates of the volume and value of honey which they expected to handle and the average returns which they anticipated paying their patrons by the end of the season. Final figures will be obtained at a later date. This information was used in calculating the weighted average price for the provinces concerned. To the extent that such returns are estimates, the 1963 values are preliminary and subject to revision.

The 1961 estimates of farm value of honey include deficiency payments to eligible producers made by the Agricultural Stabilization Board. No payments were made in respect of the 1962 and the 1963 crop.

Sources:

Estimates for the province of Quebec are prepared by the Bureau of Statistics, Department of Trade and Commerce, of that province. For all other provinces except Newfoundland, for which data are not available, the estimates are prepared by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in co-operation with the provinces. Three mail questionnaire surveys are conducted, one in July to obtain the number of colonies and another in September to determine yields per colony. A final yield and price survey is conducted at about the end of the year. Provincial officials provide the mailing lists of beekeepers and aid in the interpretation of survey results.
