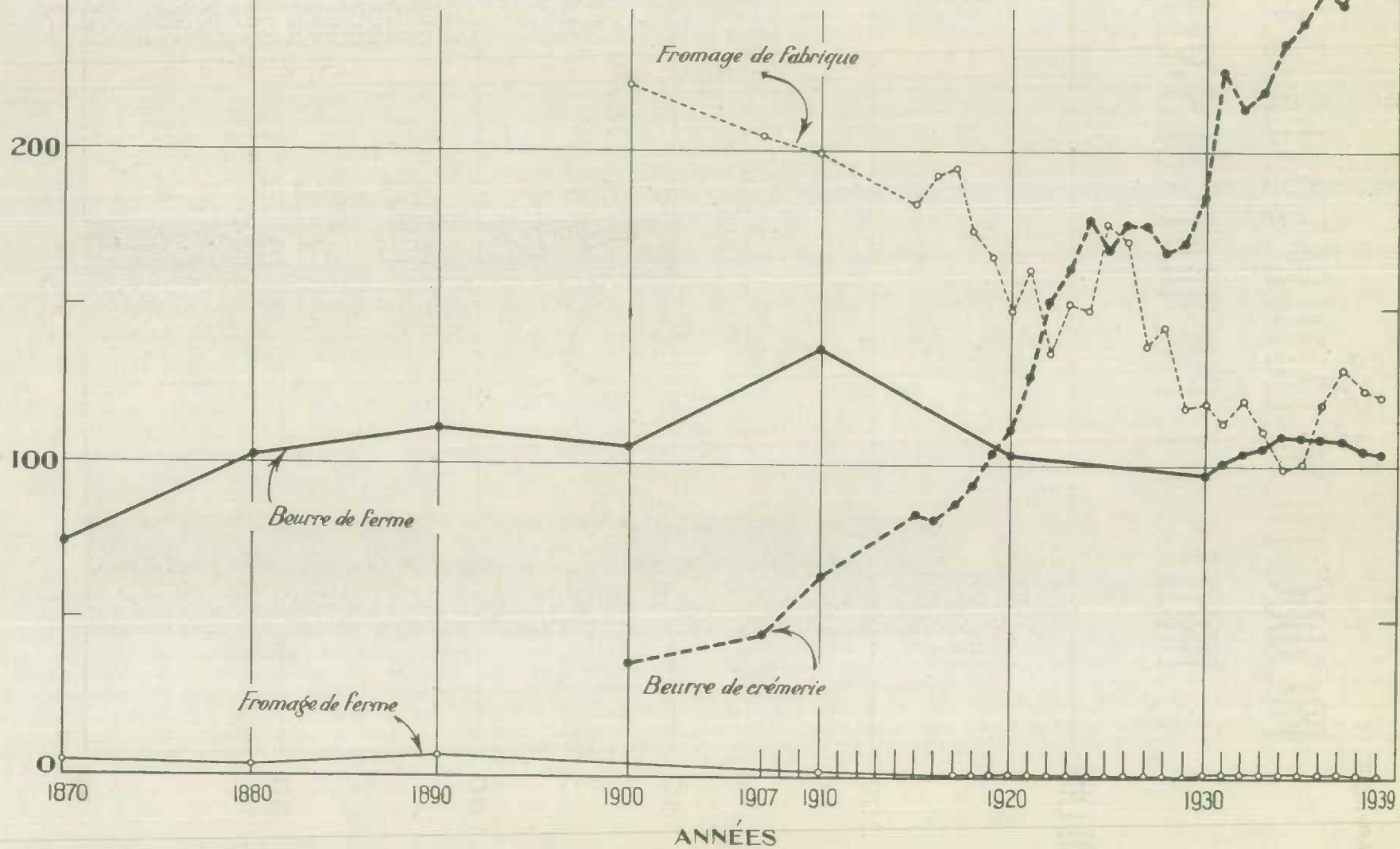
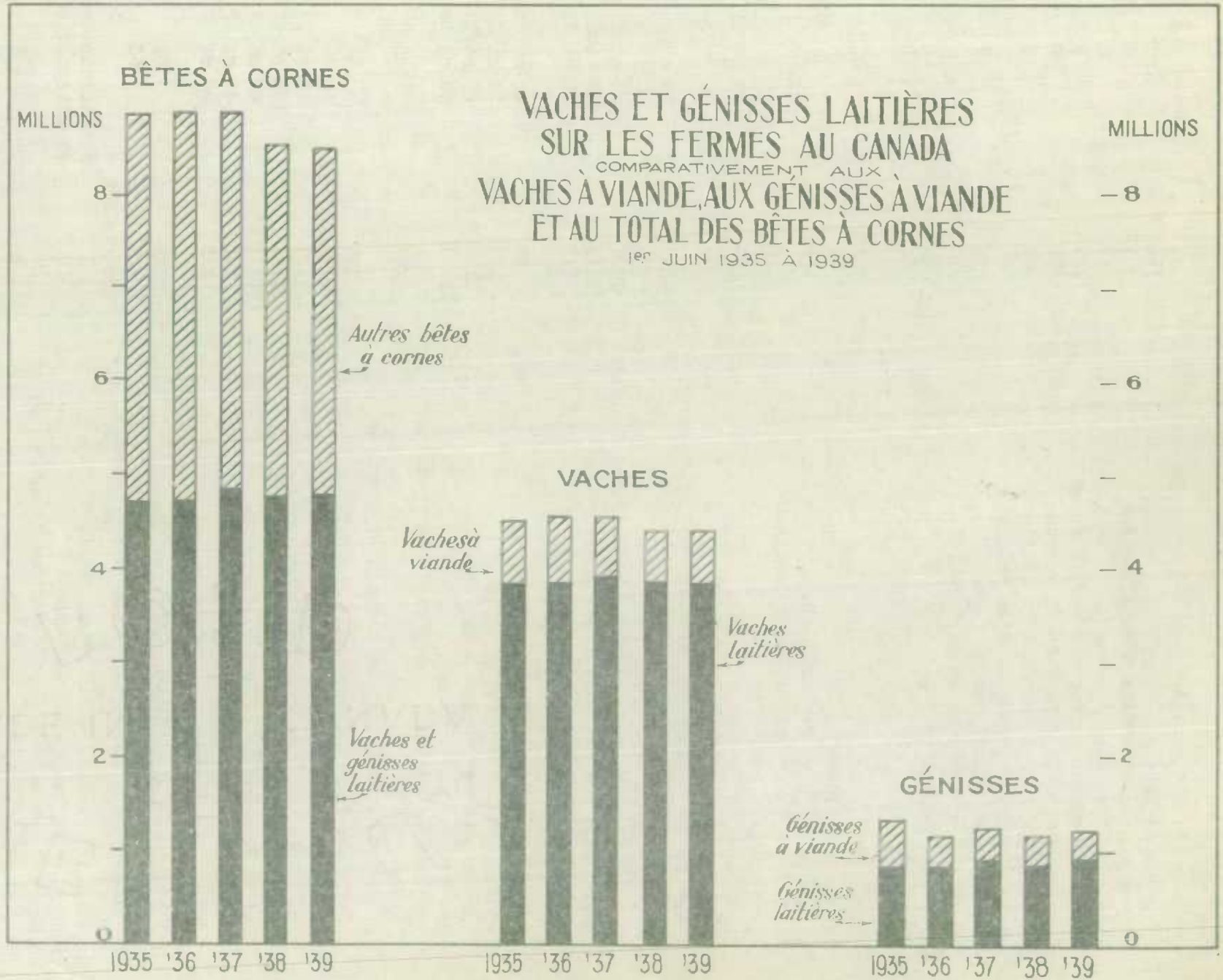

STATISTIQUES LAITIÈRES AU CANADA

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LA SITUATION DE L'INDUSTRIE LAITIÈRE

Le Bureau Fédéral de la Statistique présente ici le sixième numéro des Statistiques Laitières du Canada, couvrant l'année civile 1939. Comme dans les publications antérieures, on a tenté de réunir dans un seul rapport les principaux faits statistiques qui se rattachent à l'industrie laitière au Canada. Là où la chose est possible, les données sont groupées par période quinquennale; de cette façon, elles facilitent les comparaisons avec les années précédentes tout en donnant une vue d'ensemble de la situation statistique pendant cinq années d'expansion continue. Au cours des cinq dernières années, des prix plus favorables donnent aux cultivateurs l'occasion de contre-balancer une partie des pertes subies durant les années de dépression. L'amélioration générale de la situation du marché stimule le développement des entreprises laitières. Bien que le nombre de vaches laitières soit à peu près le même, la production laitière accuse des gains substantiels les cinq dernières années; la production de l'industrie du fromage enregistre de faibles avances et la production de beurre de crèmerie poursuit aussi une avance régulière. De même, le marché du lait fluide s'est agrandi et la croissance de l'industrie du lait concentré a donné aux producteurs de lait entier un marché supplémentaire à leur produit dans le district où ces établissements sont situés.

PRODUCTION TOTALE DE LAIT

En examinant le contenu des principaux tableaux de ce rapport, on remarquera que la production totale de lait au Canada en 1939 s'établit à 16,108,450,800 livres, soit une diminution de 25,401,200 livres comparativement à la production révisée de l'année précédente. La production combinée des provinces de Québec et d'Ontario s'élève à 10,000,000,000 de livres approximativement en 1939, ce qui représente 61.3 p.c. du rendement total; les quatre provinces de l'Ouest produisent un peu plus que 5,000,000,000 de livres ou 32.6 p.c., et les Provinces Maritimes contribuent environ 1,000,000,000 ou 6.1 p.c. Les approvisionnements de lait du Dominion sont utilisés de la façon suivante: 66 p.c. environ de la production sert à la production des produits fabriqués (beurre, fromage, crème glacée et produits de lait concentré). Les trois quarts environ du lait utilisé à cette fin sont transformés dans les fabriques laitières, tandis que l'autre quart est converti en beurre et fromage de ferme. Le "lait autrement utilisé" contribue 34 p.c., dont à peu près la moitié est vendue sous forme fluide, tandis qu'un tiers environ est consommé dans les ménages fermiers et un sixième est consacré à l'alimentation des animaux de ferme.

PRODUCTION DE BEURRE ET DE FROMAGE

La production de beurre du Canada en 1939 s'établit à 371,090,100 livres comparativement à l'estimation révisée de 372,423,271 livres en 1938. Les provinces de l'Ontario et du Québec contribuent 205,000,000 de livres ou 55.1 p.c.; les quatre provinces de l'Ouest, 141,000,000 de livres ou 38.1 p.c.; et les Provinces Maritimes, 25,000,000 de livres ou 6.8 p.c. de la production globale du Dominion. Le beurre de crèmerie compris dans ce total représente 267,368,100 livres, augmentation de seulement 20,829 livres sur l'année précédente. Le beurre de ferme est estimé à 103,722,000 livres, déclin de 1,354,000 livres ou 1.3 p.c. sur 1938. Le Québec, l'Ontario, le Manitoba, la Saskatchewan et la Colombie Britannique contribuent à l'augmentation de la production du beurre de crèmerie, tandis que les autres provinces accusent

un déclin. Les quatre provinces de l'Île du Prince-Edouard, du Manitoba, Saskatchewan et de l'Alberta, ont produit une plus grande quantité de beurre de ferme en 1939 qu'en 1938.

La production globale de fromage en 1939 est légèrement inférieure à celle de l'année précédente, soit 123,818,100 livres comparativement à 125,072,608 en 1938. Les provinces centrales (Ontario et Québec) ont produit 115,000,000 de livres en 1939 ou 93.0 p.c. de la production canadienne globale. Les quatre provinces de l'Ouest ont produit 8,000,000 de livres, dont 47.9 p.c. par le Manitoba et 31.7 p.c. par l'Alberta, tandis que les Provinces Maritimes accusent une production de 1,000,000 de livres. La production des fromageries atteint 122,771,800 livres, déclin de 1,200,000 livres ou d'environ 1.0 p.c. comparativement à la production révisé de 1938. La production de fromage sur les fermes en 1939 est de 1,046,300 livres, diminution de 55,000 livres seulement sur 1938.

Les exportations de beurre en 1939 atteignent 12,398,600 livres, comparativement à 3,893,400 livres l'année précédente. Les exportations de 1939 sont les plus considérables depuis 1925 alors que 27,000,000 de livres avaient été expédiées du Canada. Les importations s'établissent à 5,644 livres comparativement à 5,231,838 livres en 1938. Les exportations de fromage du Canada passent à 90,944,800 livres, augmentation de près de 10,000,000 de livres sur l'année précédente; ces dernières sont les plus considérables depuis 1929 alors qu'environ 93,000,000 de livres avaient été exportées.

PRODUITS CONCENTRÉS DU LAIT ET CRÈME GLACÉE

La fabrication de produits concentrés du lait entier en 1939 atteint la cime de 131,800,000 livres et celle de sous-produits augmente à 34,900,000 livres, soit une augmentation de 8.3 p.c. et une diminution de 4.0 respectivement comparativement à l'année précédente. L'article le plus important du premier groupe est le lait évaporé qui représente 88.4 p.c. de tous les produits du lait entier; la poudre de lait écrémé, dans le second groupe, représente 67.4 p.c. des sous-produits. Les expéditions de produits concentrés du lait sont principalement dirigées vers le Royaume-Uni. Les expéditions totales du Dominion s'élèvent à 34,500,000 livres, diminution de 1.7 p.c. en regard des exportations de l'année précédente; les importations se placent à 1,100,000 livres, augmentation de 21.0 p.c. par rapport aux importations de l'an dernier.

La production de crème glacée en 1939 augmente à 8,500,000 gallons, à rapprocher de 8,100,000 gallons en 1938 et 6,600,000 gallons seulement en 1935. Environ deux tiers de la production totale sont produits dans les fabriques laitières; 28.2 p.c. proviennent des établissements dont la spécialité est la crème glacée; et 10.2 p.c. sont fabriqués par l'industrie de la confiserie, de la boulangerie et de la biscuiterie.

VALEUR TOTALE DES PRODUITS LAITIERS

La valeur totale des produits laitiers au Canada en 1939 est estimée à \$217,716,029, diminution de \$8,439,267 ou de 3.7 p.c. sur l'année précédente. Il y a des déclinés en toutes les provinces excepté la Colombie Britannique. La production de beurre contribue pour 36.8 p.c. de la valeur totale des produits laitiers du Dominion; le fromage, 6.8 p.c.; le lait autrement utilisé, 39.8 p.c.; et les produits divers, 12.0 p.c.

CONSOMMATION DE PRODUITS LAITIERS

La disparition du beurre de crèmerie et du beurre de ferme au Canada atteint un total de 362,100,000 livres en 1939 et constitue environ 97.6 p.c. de la production totale. La consommation per capita est de 32 livres. La disparition domestique de fromage est inférieure à 40,000,000 de livres en 1939 et, contrairement

au beurre, ne représente qu'environ 32,3 p. 100 de la production totale. La consommation per capita en 1939 est de 3,55 livres, chiffre qui a très peu varié d'une année à l'autre. Environ 142,000,000 de livres de produits concentrés de lait sont utilisées au Canada en 1939 comparativement à moins de 79,000,000 de livres en 1930. Ce total de 142,000,000 de livres représente 84,5 p. 100 de la production totale et donne 12,56 livres pour la consommation per capita. En 1930 à peu près 71,6 p. 100 ont été utilisés dans le Dominion et la consommation per capita était de 7,72 livres. La consommation de crème glacée per capita a considérablement augmenté ces dernières années. En 1939 elle est estimée à 0,75 de gallon, tandis qu'en 1933 elle n'était que de 0,53 de gallons.

La consommation globale de lait frais, avec la crème exprimée en lait, est de 4,600,000,000 de livres ou 3,600,000,000 de pintes en 1939. C'est une consommation quotidienne pour tout le Canada de 0,87 de pinte par personne. Il est important d'observer que les producteurs de lait consomment eux-mêmes 1,25 pinte par jour tandis que les consommateurs ordinaires en achètent 0,74 de pinte par jour. Ceci explique en une certaine mesure les variations de la consommation globale dans les différentes sections du Dominion.

VALEUR ET REVENU

La valeur globale des produits laitiers au Canada en 1939 est estimée à \$217,716,029; la valeur de ferme de la production de lait est estimée à \$150,667,000; le revenu brut (comprenant la valeur des produits laitiers consommés sur les fermes) est fixée à \$145,040,000; le revenu des ventes est estimé à \$120,644,000. Comparativement à l'an dernier, il y a déclin de 3,7 p. 100, 2,5 p. 100, 2,4 p. 100 et 1,1 p. 100. La valeur globale en dollars des cent livres de lait est de \$1,35, la valeur de ferme de \$0,94, le revenu brut de \$0,90 et le revenu des ventes de \$0,75. (En analysant la valeur globale des produits laitiers par province, on voit qu'il y a déclin dans toutes les provinces excepté la Colombie Britannique.) En analysant la distribution de la valeur globale parmi les divers produits on voit que les produits du beurre contribuent 36,8 p. 100 du total. Le fromage y est pour 6,8 p. 100, les produits du lait concentré pour 12,0 p. 100, et le lait autrement utilisé pour 39,8 p. 100. La valeur globale dans ce rapport comprend les produits manufacturés aux fabriques, le lait fluide aux établissements (frais d'embouteillage et de pasteurisation) et le lait laissée sur la ferme d'après la valeur sur la ferme.

PRIX DU BEURRE ET DU FROMAGE

Le prix du beurre de crémerie à Montréal d'après les cotes quotidiennes de la Bourse canadienne des denrées pour les solides de première classe est de 23 3/4 cents en moyennes en 1939 contre 26 7/8 en 1938 et 26 1/2 en 1937. A Winnipeg le prix pour les mêmes années est de 21 7/8, 25 1/4 et 25. D'après le rapport de Montréal les prix touchent leur niveau le plus élevé à la fin de novembre avec une moyenne de 28 1/8 cents. Le point minimum est touché en avril et mai avec une moyenne de 20 7/8 cents. La différence entre le maximum de novembre (28 5/8) et le minimum d'avril (20 1/2) représente une augmentation de 8 1/8 cents. L'écart maximum en 1938 et 1939 est de 15 cents. Il se produit vers la fin de mars. L'écart minimum est de 7/8 de cent la première semaine de septembre.

Le fromage coloré d'Ontario à Montréal est de 12 5/8 cents en 1939 pour le produit de première qualité contre 14 1/4 en 1938 et 14 1/8 en 1937. D'un minimum de 9 3/4 cents en mai à un maximum de 17 3/8 en décembre résulte une différence de 8 1/8 cents. L'écart le plus grand entre 1938 et 1939 est celui de décembre alors qu'il y a une différence de 5 7/8 cents; il y a un écart moins grand à la fin de septembre et d'octobre alors que les cotes quotidiennes sont égales à celles de l'an dernier.

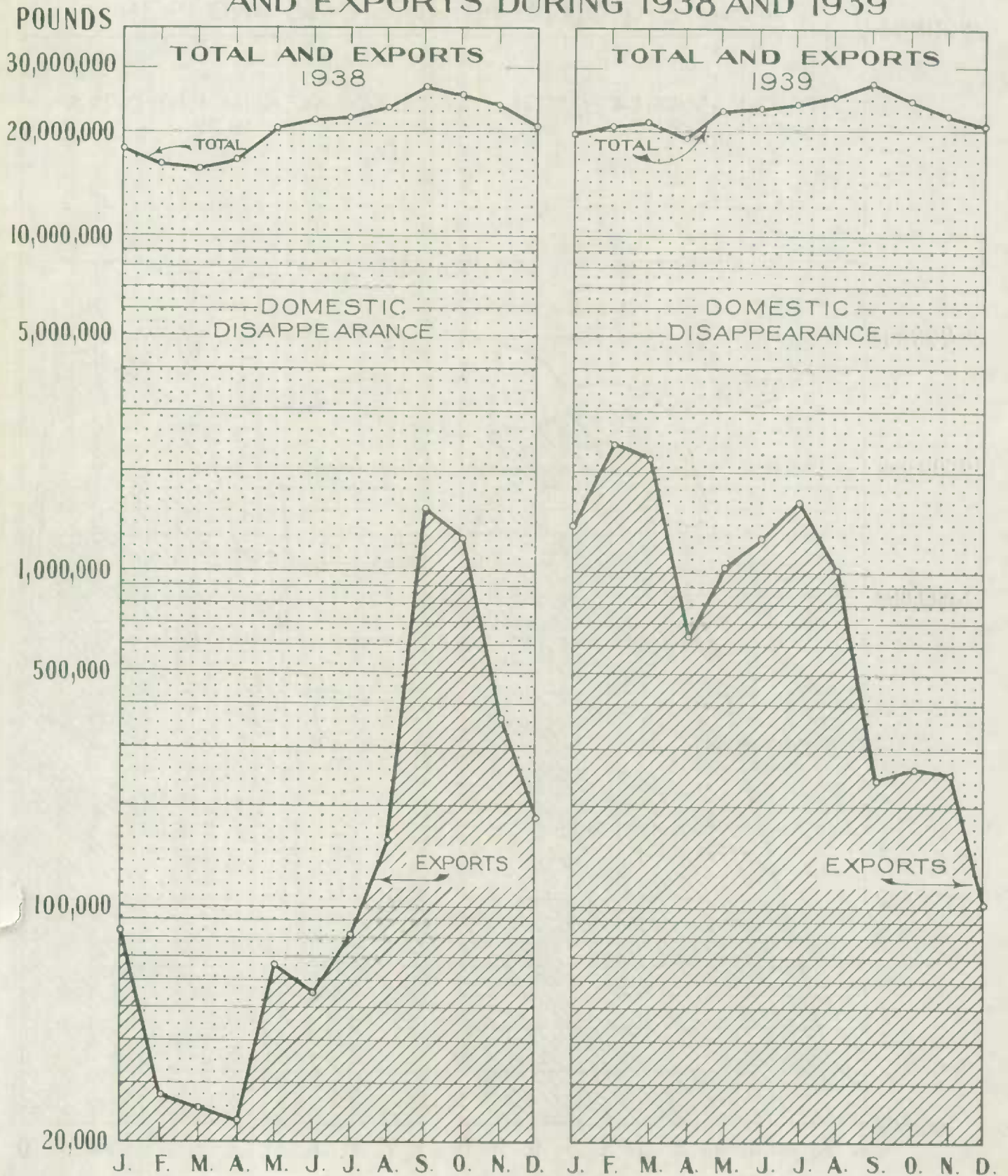

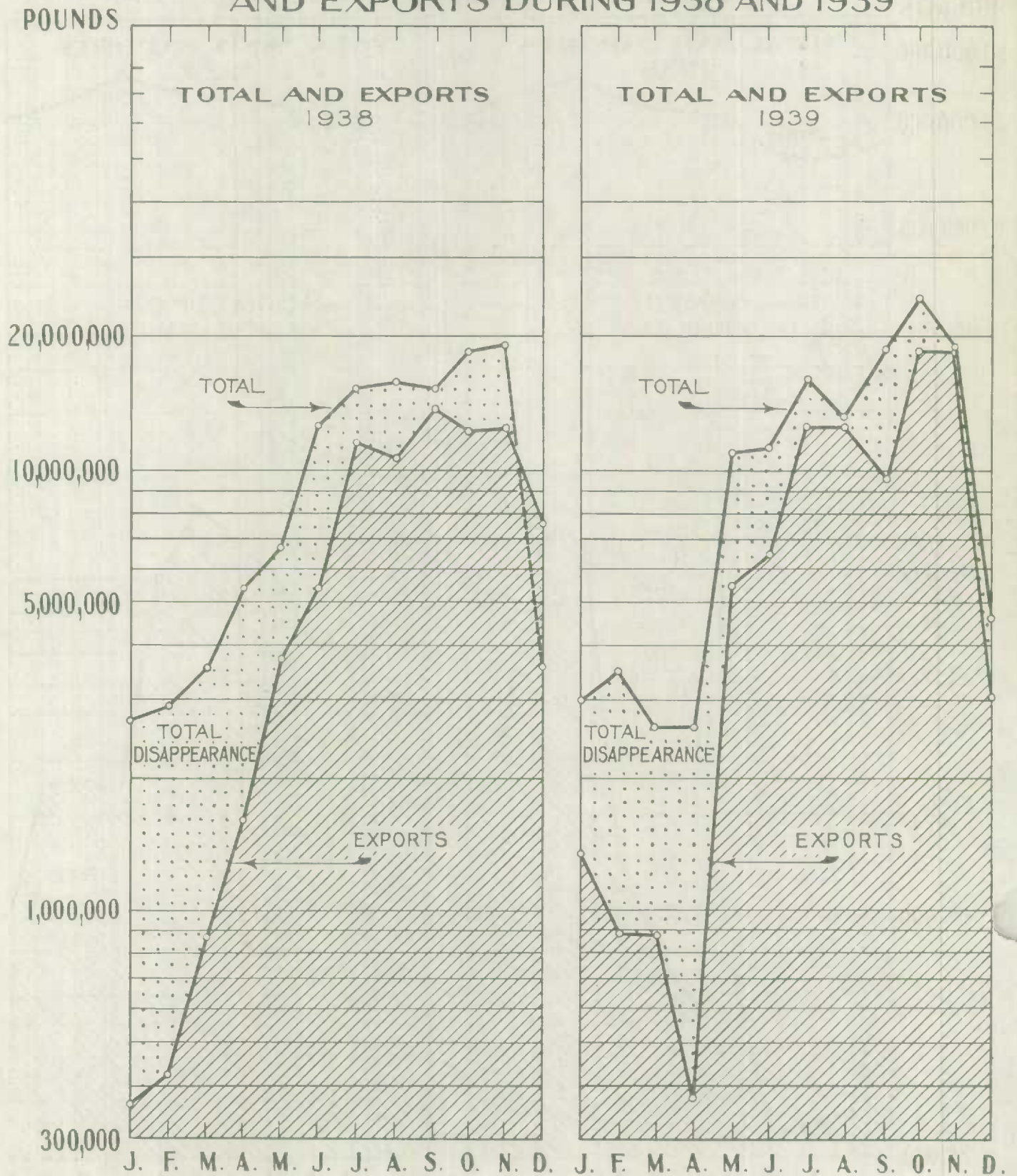

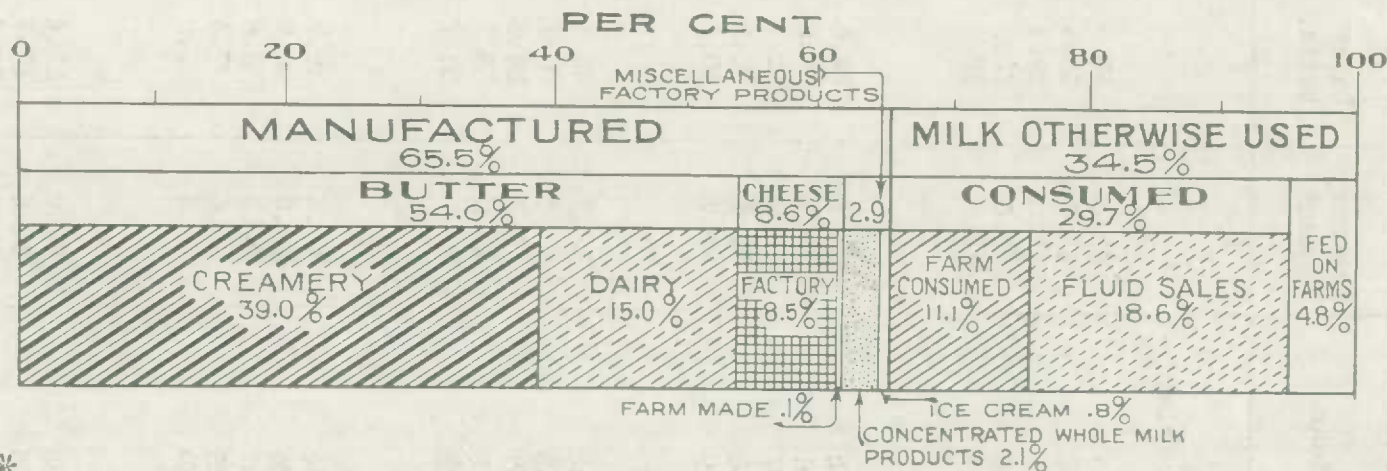

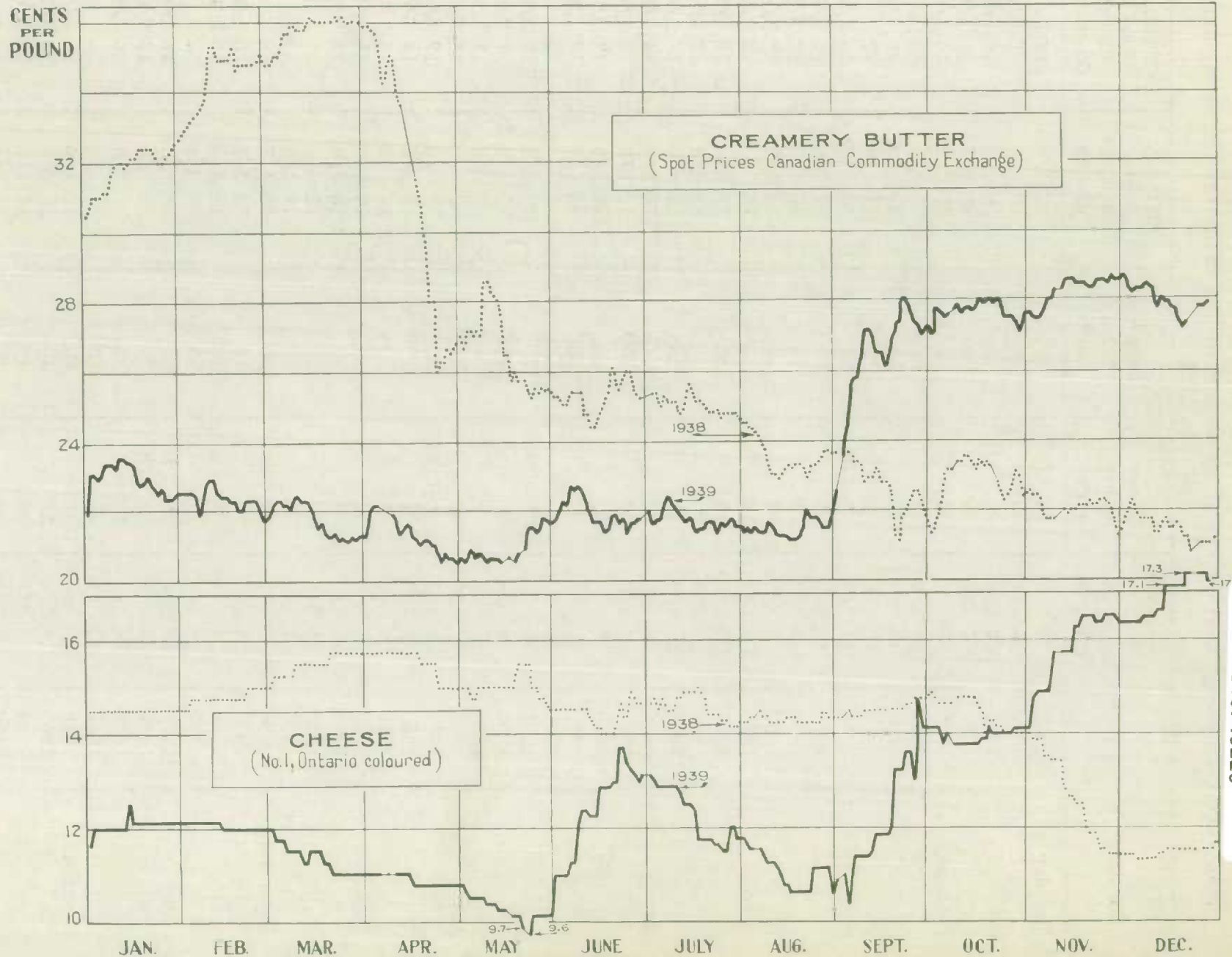
