SHORN WOOL PRODUCTION

1957

The 1957 wool clip from sheep on farms in Canada totalled 6,050 000 pounds, a decrease of 2 per cent from the revised estimate of 6,165,000 pounds in 1956. This decline in shorn wool production may be attributed to lewer sheep shorn this spring, together with a lighter average fleece weight. The comparable estimates are as follows (1956 in brackets): sheep shorn, 840,300 head (847,000); average fleece weight, 7.2 pounds (7.3).

All of the drop in shorn wool production occurred in Eastern Canada, as the West held steady at 2,946,000 pounds. Eastern farmers reported fewer sheep shorn and lighter fleeces, compared to what was reported in 1956. The estimates based on these reports are: 455,300 sheep shorn in 1957, as against 464,500 in 1956, and fleeces averaging 6.8 pounds compared to 6.9 pounds in 1956. Sheep shorn on western farms and ranches, estimated at 385,000 head, were slightly more than the 382,500 shorn in 1956. The average fleece weight remained at 7.7 pounds.

This information is derived from the Dominion Bureau of Statistics' annual wool survey. The 1956 figures have been revised to bring them into line with census information. The survey has not yet been extended to the Province of Newfoundland; consequently the Canada total figures shown in the table are for nine provinces only.
