SHORN WOOL PRODUCTION 1962

Wool production from sheep shorn in Canada this spring is estimated at 5.808.000 pounds, 6 per cent below the revised estimate of 6,169,000 pounds in 1961. The revised estimate of production in 1961 is based on the Census count of sheep on farms.

The number of sheep shorn declined almost 8 per cent, from 790,000 in 1961 to 730,000 this year, but the average weight per fleece, greasy basis. increased from 7.8 to almost 8 lb. Fleece weights were higher than last year in Prince Edward Island, Quebec and the Prairie Provinces.

Estimates of shorn wool production in Newfoundland are not available. Canada Department of Agriculture reports show that 128,317 lb. of shorn wool of Newfoundland origin were graded in 1961.
