## Memorandum

## WOOL PRODUCTION AND <br> DOMINION BUREAU sUPPLYATISTICS <br> 1955 <br> RAR 261456 <br> FROnEttry of THE

Wool production in Canada (excepting Newfoundlend for which data are not avallable) during 1955 totalled 8,041,000 pounds, only slightly below the 1954 revised total of $8,051,000$ pounds. The number of sheep shorn remained almost at the 1954 level, as did the average welcht per ileece. Wool pulled from Canadian skins during 1955 amounted to $1,595,000$ pounds, about 2.5 per cent above the 1954 total.

Exports of Canadian wool in 1955 remained ateady at 2,883,000 pounds (greasy basis) compared to the $2,865,000$ pounds shipped out of the country in the previous year. Imports, on the other hand, showed a 30 per cent increase over the 1954 total of $41,602,000$ pounds to amount to $53,954,000$ pounds in 1955. This includes pulled wool recovered in Canada from imported skins. This increase in imports led to a jump in apparent domestic disappearance of over 26 per cent. On the basis of total Canadian production, less exports, plus imports, domestic disappearance of wool in 1955 amounted to $59,112,000$ pounds.

Revised estimates of production and disappearance for the 1941-1951 intercenaal period are shown in Table 2, overleaf. These revisions were brought about by the changes made when the estimates of sheep numbers in Canada were revised following the 1951 Census.
