## WOOL PRODUCTION AND SUPPLY

1964

Wool production in Canada\* in 1964, estimated at 6,346,000 pounds, was 6.7 per cent less than in 1963. The farm output of shorn wool declined to 5,065,000 pounds from 5,259,000 pounds while pulled wool recovery dropped to 1,281,000 pounds in 1964 from 1,553,000 pounds in 1963.

Imports of wool amounted to 63,044,000 pounds, greasy basis. This was 5.4 per cent greater than 1963 imports and the largest annual total imported since 1951. Exports decreased to 3,223,000 pounds from 4,661,000 in 1963.

The preliminary estimate of the farm value of shorn wool production in 1964 is \$2,586,000. This includes deficiency payments made to producers under the provisions of the Agricultural Stablilization Act. The deficiency payment on qualifying grades of wool was 12.3 cents per pound on 1964 marketings compared with 14.3 cents per pound in 1963. Average farm value, not including deficiency payments, increased to 40.8 from 38.7 cents per pound for the 1963 clip.
