Wool production in Canada(1) in 1965 is estimated at 5,808,000 pounds down 8.5 per cent from the 6,346,000 pounds produced in 1964 and 13.6 per cent below the 1961-1965 average. Shorn wool output declined from 5,065,000 pounds in 1964 to 4,646,000 pounds in 1965 and pulled wool production decreased from 1,281,000 to 1,162,000 pounds.

Imports of wool were 65,222,000 pounds which is an increase of 5.4 per cent above the 1964 wool imports. Exports also increased from 3,223,000 to 4,236,000 pounds, an increase of 31.4 per cent.

The preliminary estimate of the farm value of shorn wool production in 1965 is \$2,196,000. This includes deficiency payments made to producers under the provisions of the Agricultural Stabilization Act. The deficiency payment on qualifying grades of wool was 16.3 cents per pound on 1965 marketings compared with 12.3 cents per pound in 1964. Average farm value, not including deficiency payments, decreased to 34.5 from 40.8 cents per pound for the 1964 clip.
