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WOOL PRODUCTION AND SUPPLY

1966

Wool production in Canada(1) in 1966 is estimated at 5,045,000 pounds down 13.3 per cent from the 5,815,000 pounds produced in 1965 and 25.0 per cent below the 1961-1965 average of 6,719,600. Shorn wool production decreased 10.2 per cent from 4,653,000 pounds in 1965 to 4,178,000 pounds in 1966, and pulled wool output declined by 25.4 per cent to 867,000 pounds in 1966 from 1,162,000 in 1965.

Imports of wool in 1966 at 61,917,000 pounds were down 5.1 per cent from 65,-222,000 pounds in 1965. Exports decreased 28.7 per cent from 4,236,000 pounds in 1965 to 3,021,000 pounds in 1966.

The preliminary estimate of the farm valve of shorn wool production in 1966 is \$1,990,000. This includes deficiency payments made to producers under the provisions of the Agricultural Stabilization Act. The deficiency payment on qualifying grades of wool was 18.3 cents per pound on 1966 marketings compared with 16.3 cents per pounds in 1965. The Average farm price, not including deficiency payments, declined to 34.0 from 34.5 cents per pound for the 1965 clip.
