## THE ANTICIPATED PELT PRODUCTION ON FUR FARMS CANADA - 1960

According to pelting intentions reported in a sample survey of fur farms the number of mink to be pelted this fall and winter will be approximately 1,147,000; close to ten per cent greater than the current estimate of last year's output of 1,044,700 mink pelts. Increases are expected in the number of standard, brown, beige, and white pelts, but the number of grey and blue pelts will be less than in 1959. While the number of mink on farms at the beginning of the year was nearly nine per cent greater than in 1959 the estimated number of kits raised increased by twelve per cent. According to the survey ranchers plan on retaining somewhat more mink for breeding stock than was the case in 1959.

This is the second forecast in which a detailed colour phase breakdown for mink peltings has been attempted. It is to be expected that forecasts by colour phase may be less accurate than forecasts for total peltings. The current estimate of 1,044,700 mink pelts produced in 1959 is about two per cent higher than the advance estimate of 1,022,000 published in November 1959 before pelting commenced. The increase in output of dark, brown, and white pelts was greater than had been forecast while most other colour types fell slightly below the forecast.
