## THE ANTICIPATED PELT PRODUCTION ON FUR FARMS CANADA - 1961

According to pelting intentions reported in a sample survey of fur farms the number of mink to be pelted this fall and winter will be approximately 1,254,000, four per cent greater than the current estimate of last year's output of 1,205,000 mink pelts. Increases are expected in the number of blue, brown and beige pelts, but the number of standard, grey and white pelts will be less than in 1960. According to the survey ranchers are planning a moderate increase in the number of mink retained for breeding stock.

This is the third forecast in which a detailed colour phase breakdown for mink peltings has been attempted. It is to be expected that forecasts by colour phase may be less accurate than forecasts for total peltings. The current estimate of 1,205,000 mink pelts produced in 1960 is about 14 per cent higher than the production of 1,054,741 pelts in 1959 whereas the advance forecast indicated an increase of 9 per cent. Apparently with the decline in pelt prices in 1960 ranchers did not expand breeding stock for 1961 as much as they had planned to before pelting commenced.
