## THE ANTICIPATED PELT PRODUCTION ON FUR FARMS

CANADA - 1962

According to pelting intentions reported in a sample survey of fur farms the number of mink to be pelted this fall and winter will be approximately 1,302,400, three per cent greater than the current estimate of last year's output of 1,264,300 mink pelts. Increases are expected in the number of grey, blue and beige pelts, but the number of standard, brown and white pelts will be less than in 1961. According to the survey, ranchers are planning to retain approximately 16 per cent more mink for breeding stock. These reported intentions may be modified to some extent by economic conditions at pelting time.

This is the fourth annual forecast in which a detailed colour phase breakdown for mink peltings has been attempted. It is to be expected that forecasts by colour phase may be less accurate than forecasts for total peltings. The current estimate of 1961 mink pelt production of fur farms, at 1,264,300, is about 10,000, or 0.8 per cent, higher than the advance estimate of 1961 peltings published a year ago.
