THE ANTICIPATED FELT PRODUCTION ON FUR FARMS

CANADA - 1963

According to pelting intentions reported in a sample survey of fur farms the number of mink to be pelted this fall and winter will be approximately 1,392,700, six per cent greater than the current estimate of last year's output of 1,313,000 mink pelts. Increases are expected in the number of darks, light blue, brown and beige pelts, but the number of grey, dark blue and white pelts will be less than in 1962. According to the survey, ranchers are planning to retain approximately seven per cent more mink for breeding stock. These reported intentions may be modified to some extent by economic conditions at pelting time.

This is the fifth annual forecast in which a detailed colour phase breakdown for mink peltings has been atempted. It is to be expected that forecasts by colour phase may be less accurate than forcasts for total peltings. The current estimate of mink pelt production on fur farms in 1962 is about 11,000 or 0.8 per cent higher than the advance estimate published a year ago.
