PRODUCTION AND VALUE ESTIMATE OF HONEY, 1972

The estimate for the 1972 honey crop stands at 50.6 million pounds, a decrease of 1.4 million pounds from the revised 1971 production of 52.0 million pounds. However, the 1972 honey outturn is significantly above the 1960-69 average of 40.3 million pounds. The decrease in the 1972 production, as compared to that of 1971, was primarily due to unseasonable weather conditions causing the average yield per colony to decrease by nine pounds. The 1972 average yields per colony were lower than those of 1971 in all provinces except Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, Ontario and Manitoba.

The estimated total value of honey, in thousands of dollars, produced in the various provinces in 1972, with 1971 figures in brackets, is as follows: Prince Edward Island 21 (9), Nova Scotia 137 (59), New Brunswick 64 (72), Quebec 656 (807), Ontario 2,147 (1,587), Manitoba 2,843 (1,500), Saskatchewan 2,566 (1,600), Alberta 6,045 (4283), and British Columbia 1,144 (904).

Beekeepers replying to the questionnaire on which this report is based, i.e. The October Honey Survey, were asked to give (or estimate) volume and price figures for honey sold (or to be sold) in bulk and retail containers. This information received from the beekeepers was used in calculating a weighted average price for the provinces concerned. Since much of the 1972 price data received from the beekeepers are forecasts, the 1972 value figures are preliminary and subject to revision.

Source: Estimates for the province of Quebec are prepared by the Bureau of Statistics, Department of Trade and Commerce, of that province. For all other provinces except Newfoundland, for which data are not available, the estimates are prepared by Statistics Canada in co-operation with the provinces. Two mail questionnaire surveys are conducted, one in July to obtain an estimate on the number of colonies and another in October to determine the yields per colony and the average price per pound. Provincial officials provide the mailing lists of beekeepers and aid in the interpretation of survey results.
