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REPORT ON CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTS, CANADA,  
DECEMBER, 1929.

Statistics of the production of condensed and evaporated milk, milk powder, etc., in December, 1929, are based on the returns of the 26 firms which manufactured these products during the month.

Production in December shows a falling-off from the preceding month for nearly all items, the exceptions being whole milk powder and buttermilk powder, for which increased quantities are recorded. The total export of concentrated milk products was slightly greater than in the month of November; the quantities of condensed milk and milk powder show increases, while a decrease is recorded for evaporated milk. The quantity of products in cold storage was also greater in December, the total of all kinds amounting to 8,984,407 lb. in comparison with 8,039,631 lb. in November.

The following tables give statistics of production, imports and exports and storage holdings for November and December, cumulative production for the six months ended December 31, 1929, and production for the calendar year 1928.
