REPORT ON CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTS, CANADA, JANUARY, 1930.

The present report of production is based on the returns of the 25 firms in Canada which manufactured during the month of January, 1930, any of the various items under the head of "concentrated milk."

Production as a whole for the month of January shows a decrease from the preceding month of about 500,000 pounds. Condensed milk decreased by 136,000 pounds and evaporated milk by 700,000 pounds. Condensed skim milk and skim milk powder show slight increases. The quantity of concentrated milk products exported shows a decrease from the month of December of 50 per cent. The stock in cold storage warehouses at date of February 1 also shows a decrease from the quantity reported for January 1. The following tables show production, imports and exports and stocks in storage, by items.
