REPORT ON CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTS, CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1930.

The report on the production of concentrated milk for the month of February, 1930, has been prepared from statements furnished the Bureau by the 26 firms which manufactured any of these products during the month.

Continued decrease in the production of concentrated milk is shown by the returns for February, the decrease from the preceding month amounting to a little over one million pounds. All items show decreases excepting evaporated skim milk, whole milk powder and skim milk powder. Condensed milk decreased by about six hundred thousand pounds and evaporated milk by over three hundred thousand pounds. The trade tables show decreases of 354,900 pounds and 129,800 pounds respectively in the exports of condensed milk and evaporated milk, and an increase of 175,500 pounds in the export of milk powder. Returns of cold storage warehouses for March 1, show decreased quantities on hand of condensed and evaporated milk and whole milk powder, with a slightly larger quantity of skim milk powder.
