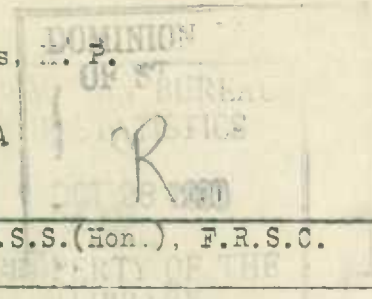

REPORT ON CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTS, CANADA, SEPTEMBER, 1930

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in September, 1930, are based on the result on the compilation of returns from the 28 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items comprised in the general term "concentrated milk".

Production during the month of September, 1930, fell short of that of the preceding month by about two million pounds and of the month of September, 1929, by about one million pounds. The total of all items in September, 1930, was 8,842,372 pounds in comparison with 10,972,960 pounds in the previous month and 9,954,431 pounds in September, 1929. The principal items are condensed milk, evaporated milk and skim milk powder, and these all show decreased production in comparison with the preceding month and with the month of September, 1929, as well. The combined production of all items for the nine months January to September, 1930 amounted to 90,710,956 pounds, or an average per month of 10,078,995 pounds.

The exports for September show increases over the preceding month for condensed milk and milk powder, with a decrease recorded for evaporated milk. The imports of concentrated milk products are of relatively small importance and include only two items, viz., condensed milk and casein, the imports of the former amounting in September to only 21,504 pounds and of the latter to 15,299 pounds. Stocks of concentrated milk products in cold storage warehouses at date of October 1, 1930, show decreases from the preceding month for all items.

The following tables give statistics of production, imports and exports and cold storage holdings.
