## REPORT ON CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA

SEPTEMBER, 1931.

Number of Factories.- Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in September, 1931, are based on the returns of the 28 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items included under the general head of "concentrated milk".

Production.- The usual seasonal decline in the production of concentrated milk is shown by the September returns, the total for the month amounting to 6,284,276 pounds, a drop from the preceding month of 1,419,591 pounds, or 18 per cent. A decrease is also shown from the month of September, 1930, of 2,558,096 pounds, or 29 per cent. The months of highest production for most items are April to August. In 1931 the high records for condensed milk and skim milk powder were in May, and for evaporated milk the high record was reached in June.

Cumulative Production.- The combined production of all items for the nine months ended September 30, 1931, was 71,941,884 pounds, compared with 90,710,956 in the corresponding period of 1930. The quantity of condensed milk made in the nine months of 1931 was less than in the nine months of 1930 by 30 per cent, of evaporated milk by 20 per cent, and of skim milk powder by 11 per cent.

Imports and Exports.- The exports of condensed milk and evaporated milk in September, 1931, were less than in the preceding month while the export of milk powder shows a slight increase. Compared with a year ago, all items show decreases in export, particularly condensed milk, which dropped from 1,853,500 pounds to 669,800 pounds, and evaporated milk, which dropped from 1,063,200 pounds to 271,200 pounds.
