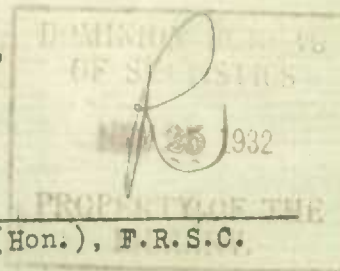

CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, OCTOBER, 1932

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in October, 1932, are based on returns furnished by the 27 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items listed under the general classification of "concentrated milk," i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production.- The combined production of all items of concentrated milk during the month of October, 1932, amounted to 5,821,110 pounds, compared with 7,288,247 pounds in September and 5,640,665 pounds in October, 1931. The usual seasonal decline common to all dairy products is responsible for the decrease from September.

Cumulative Production.- The total of all items for the ten months ended October 31, 1932, was 73,240,086 pounds, compared with 77,286,082 pounds in the corresponding period of 1931.

Foreign Trade.- The exports of condensed milk in October, 1932, amounted to 949,500 pounds, of evaporated milk, 949,500 pounds and of milk powder 430,600 pounds. The first two items show increases compared with a year ago, while milk powder shows a decrease. There were no exports of casein, but 21,952 pounds were imported. Condensed milk was the only other item of concentrated milk imported in October, with a total of 192 pounds.

Storage Warehouse Holdings.- Total storage holdings at date of November 1, 1932, were slightly less than at the same date in 1931. Condensed milk and milk powder show decreases, but evaporated milk records an increase of nearly a million pounds.
