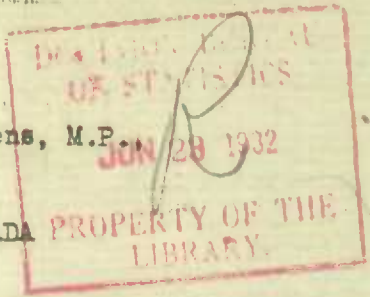

REPORT ON CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, MAY, 1932.

Statistics of the Production of Concentrated Milk in Canada in May, 1932, are based on the returns of the 27 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items comprised in the term "concentrated milk", viz., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production.- The combined production of all items in May, 1932, was 9,451,255 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 1,633,624 pounds, but a decrease from May, 1931, of 2,006,957 pounds. The principal item in the May production was evaporated milk, which amounted to 6,270,856 pounds, an increase over the preceding month of 1,398,717 pounds, and a decrease from May, 1931, of only 194,575 pounds.

Cumulative Production.- The total production of all items for the five months ended May 31, 1932, was 31,235,412 pounds, compared with 34,593,338 pounds in the corresponding period of 1931.

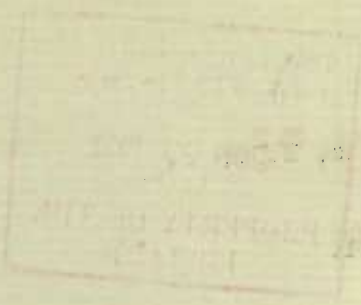
Imports and Exports.- The total export of concentrated milk in May, 1932, shows an increase over April, and little change from May, 1931. The export of evaporated milk was twice as large as in April, and records an increase over May, 1931, of 204,700 pounds, or 26 per cent. The exports of condensed milk and milk powder, on the other hand, were less than in May, 1931. The imports of concentrated milk products are of relatively small importance, the total of all items in May, 1932, amounting to only 17,094 pounds.

Storage Warehouse Holdings.- The quantity of evaporated milk held in storage warehouses in May, 1932, was 7,893,743 pounds, compared with 7,457,451 pounds in May, 1931. Other principal items - condensed milk, whole milk powder, and skim milk powder - record decreases compared with a year ago.
