CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, JULY, 1932.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in July, 1932, are based on the returns furnished by the 26 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items comprised under the general head of "concentrated milk".

i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Froduction.— The total output of concentrated milk, covering all items, in July, 1932, was 9,127,424 pounds, compared with 10,866,152 pounds in the preceding month and 10,192,227 pounds in July, 1931. The production of condensed milk amounted to 1,495,157 pounds, an increase over June of 52½ per cent and an increase over July, 1931, of 10 per cent. The production of casein also records an increase over the preceding month and over July, 1931. Decreases are shown for most of the other items.

Cumulative Production. - The total production of all items during the seven months ended July 31, 1932, was 51,228,988 pounds, compared with 57,733,093 pounds in the corresponding period of 1931.

Foreign Trade. The quantities of concentrated milk exported in July, 1932, were much greater than those in both the preceding month and the month of July, 1931. The export of condensed milk increased over July, 1931, by 33 per cent, evaporated milk by 99½ per cent, and milk powder by 27 per cent. There was a considerable quantity of milk powder imported in July, 1932, but the imports of the other items of concentrated milk were small.

Storage Warehouse Holdings. Storage holdings were less than at date of August lst a year ago for condensed milk, whole milk powder, skim milk powder and casein, with larger stocks recorded for the other items. The combined total of all items shows a decrease from a year ago of about a million pounds.
