CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, JULY, 1933

Statistics of concentrated milk production for the month of July, 1933, are based on the returns of the 30 firms whose factories manufactured any of the various items included under this head, viz., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production.— The combined total production of the items of concentrated milk in July, 1933, was 8,493,289 pounds, a decrease of 2,559,471 pounds from the preceding month and a decrease of 634,135 pounds from July, 1932. Compared with the production of a year ago, evaporated milk records an increase, but decreases are shown for condensed milk and skim milk powder.

Cumulative Production.— The production of all items for the seven months ended July 31, 1933, amounted to 49,537,088 pounds, compared with a total of 51,228,988 pounds for the corresponding period of 1932.

Foreign Trade.— The chief item in the export of concentrated milk products is evaporated milk, the quantity exported in July, 1933, amounting to 1,280,900 pounds. The export of condensed milk totalled 184,400 pounds and of milk powder, 535,100 pounds. Statistics of the imports of concentrated milk products for the month of July, 1933, are not available at the present date, but may be obtained later from the External Trade Branch of the Bureau.

Storage Holdings.— The storage holdings of concentrated milk products at date of August 1, 1933, were less for all items than at the same date in 1932. Evaporated milk, the principal item, shows a decrease of five million pounds.
