

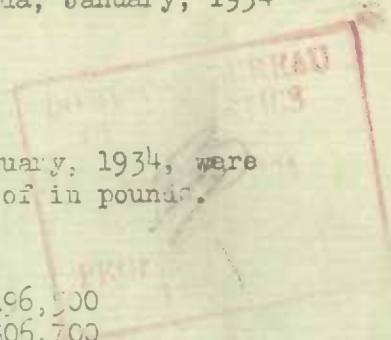

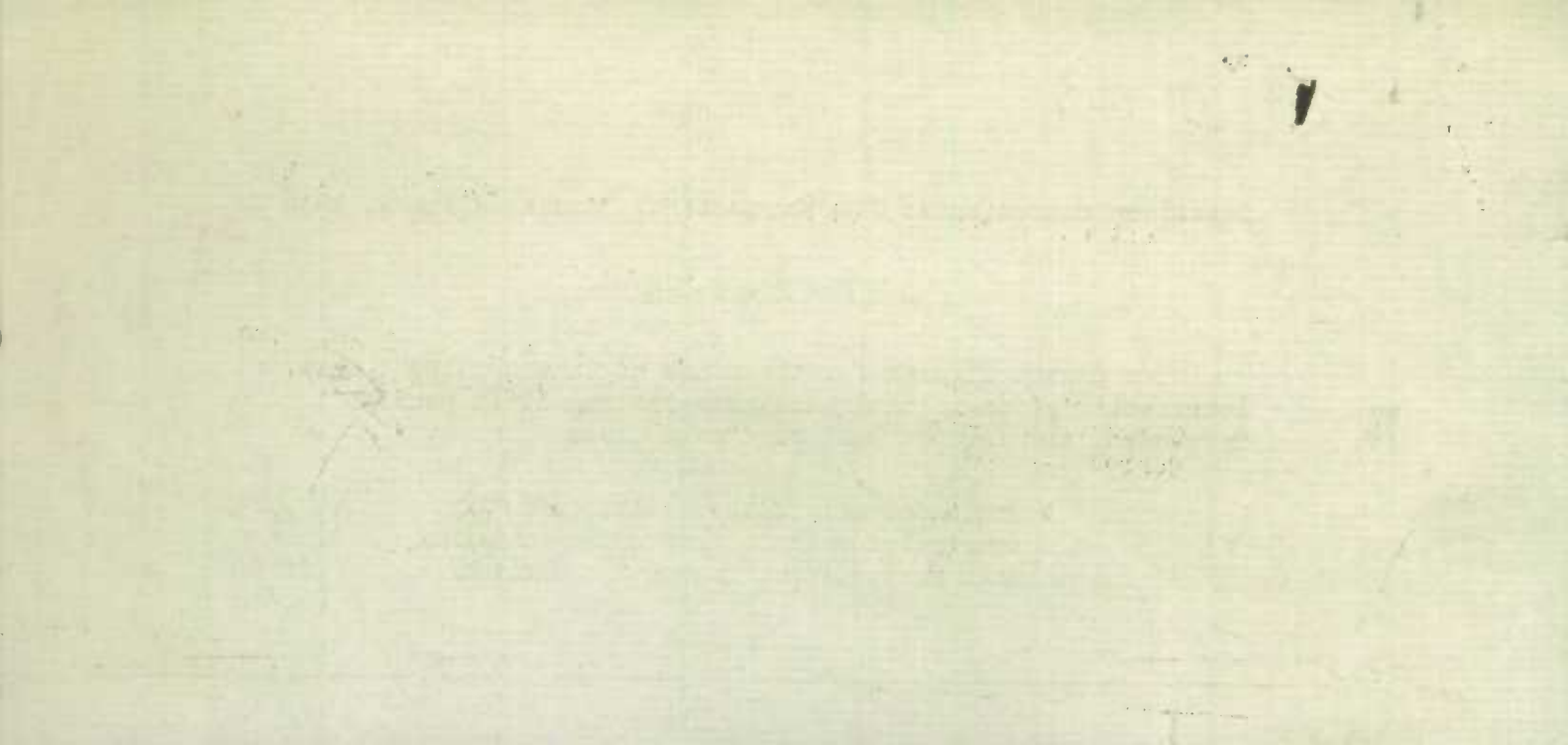
Report on Concentrated Milk Production, Canada, January, 1934

CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, JANUARY, 1934.

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in January, 1934, are based on returns from the 29 companies whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items listed under the general classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production as a whole during the month of January was considerably in excess of the output of January, 1933. The combined total for all items in January, 1934, was 5,213,662 pounds, compared with 4,126,962 pounds in January of last year. The following tables give production by items, imports and exports, and storage holdings.
