CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, FEBRUARY, 1934

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in February, 1934, are based on returns from the 29 companies whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items listed under the general classification of "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

The combined production of all items of concentrated milk in February, 1934, was 4,771,393 pounds, exceeding the total of February, 1933, by 816,481 pounds, or 21 per cent. The increase in the production of evaporated milk is especially noticeable, the quantity made (case and bulk goods) amounting to 3,076,682 pounds, in comparison with 1,845,124 pounds in the corresponding month of 1933, an increase of 67 per cent.
