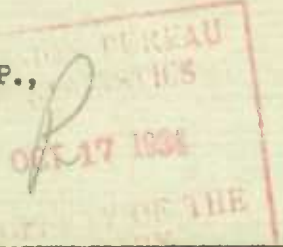

CONCENTRATED MILK PRODUCTION, CANADA, SEPTEMBER, 1934

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in September are based on returns from the 31 companies whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items classified as "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production.- Combining all items, the total production of concentrated milk for the month of September, 1934, was 8,872,924 pounds, a decrease from the preceding month of 749,517 pounds, or 8 per cent, but an increase over September, 1933, of 441,647 pounds, or 5 per cent. Evaporated milk shows a decrease as compared with 1933, but increases are noted in the production of condensed milk and skim milk powder.

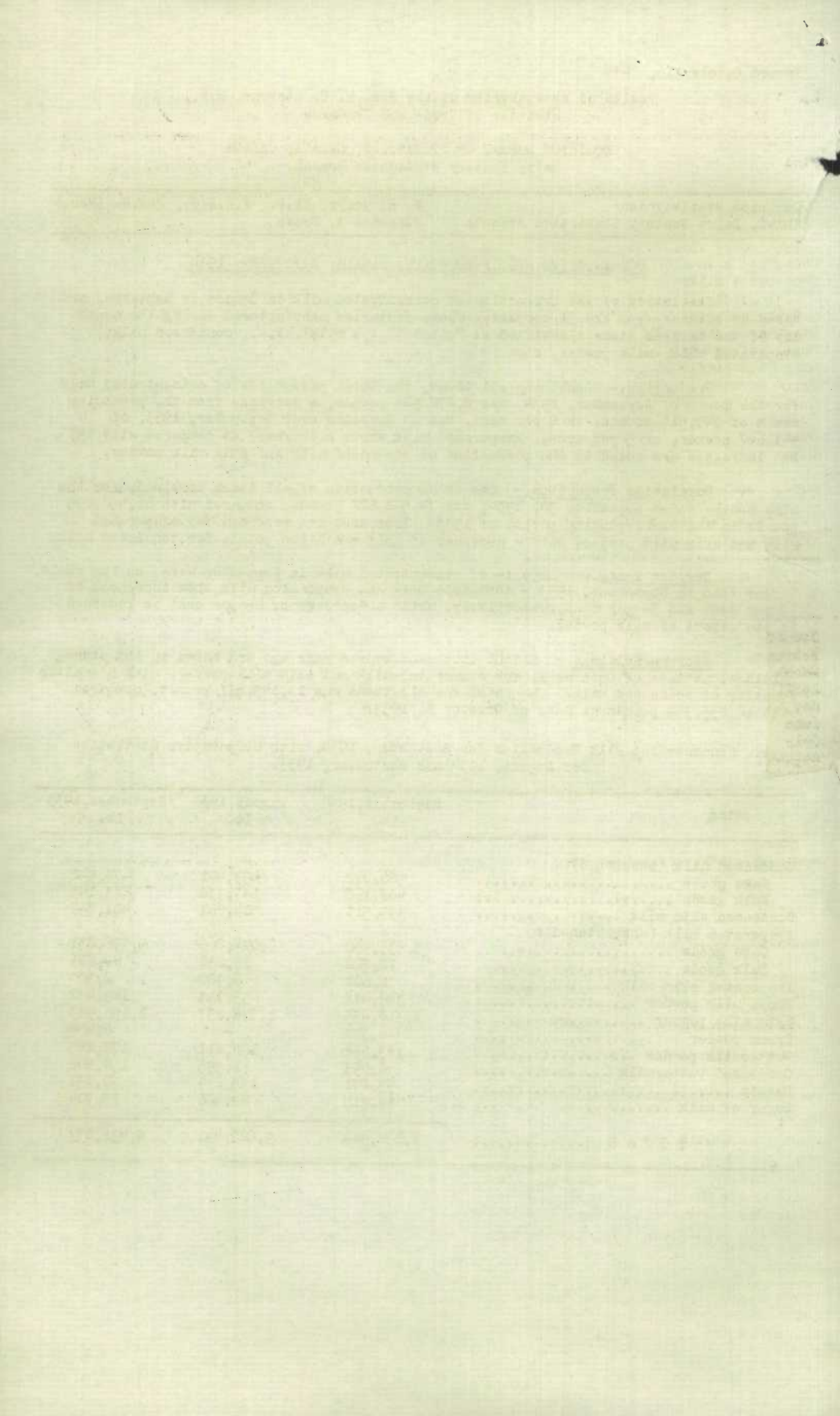
Cumulative Production.- The total production of all items combined, for the nine months ended September 30, 1934, was 74,542,622 pounds, compared with 66,552,895 pounds in the corresponding period of 1933. Increases are recorded for evaporated milk and skim milk powder, with a decrease of half a million pounds for condensed milk.

Foreign Trade.- Exports of concentrated milk in September were, on the whole, larger than in September, 1933 - condensed milk and evaporated milk show increases of 99 per cent and 34 per cent respectively, while a decrease of 45 per cent is recorded in the export of milk powder.

Storage Holdings.- Slight increases over a year ago are shown in the storage holdings, at date of October 1, for evaporated milk and skim milk powder, with a smaller quantity of condensed milk. The total for all items was 14,145,677 pounds, compared with 12,835,354 pounds at date of October 1, 1933.
