PRODUCTION OF CONCENTRATED MILK, JANUARY, 1935

Statistics of the production of concentrated milk in Canada in January, 1935, are based on returns from the 32 firms whose factories manufactured during the month any of the various items included in the classification "concentrated milk", i.e., condensed milk, evaporated milk, milk powder, etc.

Production. - The combined production of all items of concentrated milk in January amounted to 4,732,759 pounds, compared with 4,600,314 pounds in December and 5,213,662 pounds in January, 1934.

In the following tables will be found statistics of production, imports and exports, and storage holdings, of concentrated milk, by items:
